

Reminder:

If this process is followed, the Recorder can call the Dramadarie group to perform the 1st degree ritual at the upcoming Annual Meeting. Please follow this process and make life easier for all.

#2— Information for all Shriners: If someone wants to donate to Mt. Sinai and expect to get a tax credit it cannot be done, unless they earmark the donation to go to one of our hospitals. Reason:

Mt. Sinai is no longer has a 501C-3 designation. We do have a 501C-10 designation. This came about when we were being looked at by Imperial who informed your Divan, that they had to change the tax designation. That has been done through the VT Tax Department legally.

#3—We are currently accepting TT's Booster fees of \$20 per line item.

#4—We had to suspend (14) members from our membership for dues unpaid for 2018. Hopefully we can cut that figure down for 2019.
