Dear Mike,

We hope this note finds you well. While it seems like spring has only just begun here in Boston, we are already looking ahead to the upcoming holiday season and starting to plan for our busiest time of year. Your thoughtfulness and generosity toward our children and their families is deeply appreciated.

Shriners Hospitals for Children - Boston continues to go through a transition process that will likely result in sharing space with our affiliate in the coming years. That change will have a significant impact on our storage capacity. In 2019, we are asking you, our generous in-kind donors, to consider making monetary donations or donations of gift cards. This will allow us the flexibility to provide critically injured patients and their families with exactly what they need, at the time that they need it, without having to store items. In addition, our hospital fundraising goal has increased \$75,000 from last year. Your monetary donation or gift cards will make a world of difference to children and their families when they arrive at Shriners Hospitals for Children - Boston in need of immediate life-changing care.

Recently, we admitted three siblings who were burned in a house fire. They arrived the week before Christmas, with their parents by their side. Along with receiving treatment from our acute burn care team, our Child Life department outfitted the family with specific clothes, personal necessities and age-appropriate toys to make their stay at the hospital more comfortable. We purchased favorite stuffed animals, blankies similar to those lost in the fire, and ensured that Santa visited each sibling on Christmas morning. The generosity of our donors made that possible. Each child has recovered and the entire family had an overwhelmingly positive experience at the Boston Shriners Hospital.

We hope that you will continue to feel inspired to give generously so that we can support all children and families when they need us most. This change in our giving procedures in no way diminishes the significance of your gift. In fact, it will allow us to tailor match clothing, toys and other necessities for every child and family throughout the year. Thank you in advance for your understanding and generosity.
