might have omitted) it might not have ended up as we hoped but ended up as it was intended. It's been a wild ride, looking forward to seeing what the future has to hold.



#### **Temple Money Policy**

Let it be known for the ensuing year of 2021 this policy will be in place as COVID has changed the way we operate. This will keep the financial health of the Temple in mind.

Treasurer will give a Monthly report on what is in our bank accounts at the Stated Divan meeting and Ceremonials.

All expenses will be reviewed Monthly at the stated Divan meeting.

Divan members are encouraged to ask questions about expenses.


Any Bill(s) or Monies that need to be paid out over \$50.00 need to be brought first to the Potentate's attention via email. Then an action plan can be put in place to either pay or review at next Stated Divan meeting.

No new expenses should be incurred without the knowledge of first the Potentate and then the Divan.

A record will be kept at the Office of all Monies coming into the Temple to include: Check Number, Check Date, Check Amount, who it is from and Cash will be logged as well as to who it was from, amount.

Deposits into the Bank should be done weekly or greater then \$100.00 in cash or checks.

Violation(s) of this policy will be brought to the Potentate's attention then shared with the Divan for what corrective actions shall be taken in accordance with Shrine Law or Temple By-laws.



# Fast Track Video Visits provide compassionate, topnotch care – virtually
