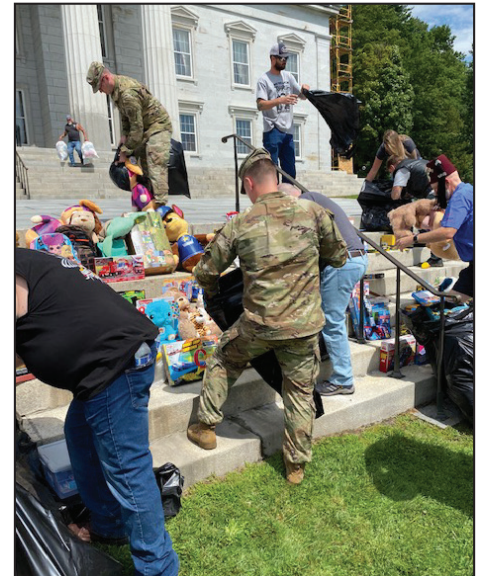

Reviewed the qualifications for Board membership and responsibilities

Very interesting presentation on Music Therapy, which enhances the patient experience and improves outcomes. Imagine the boost for a double amputee child, learning to play a ukulele – without hands - and writing his own songs.

The Boston hospital is still accepting patients, despite the coronavirus resurgence. They're also working with other agencies to allow international patients, including two from the Dominican Republic.

Facilities: designers and architects are engaged for the new hospital building.

Net patient revenue is up 120% vs last year

Outpatient volumes are up as Covid receded in July

The hospital received 2 6-figure gifts in July. In total, \$2.6 million including other contributions.

82% participation in the "Virtual Walk" from Associate members but less from full Board members, in the 60%+ range. (Yes, this reporter HAS donated)

Website is close to be finished, perhaps next week.
