Happy 50th Birthday to the Motor Corp. 1971

Seems just like yesterday as we are all still tearing up the streets at parades.

Enjoying the High 5's, many smiles and eager faces watching as we go up and over the limo.

The Northern Vermont Shrine Club had a few of its members who felt that it would be fun to have a bus that we could go the Temple with and maybe participate in parades. With this in mind, in 1971, Bob Bliss, Wes Kidder, Bob Barker, and Merrill Hungerford bought a bus that was an airport limousine and proceeded to get it painted up with all of the Shrine symbols and colors. It provided transportation for about twelve of its people.

However, in 1972 we bought six Go Karts with the idea we could have more participation from the Nobility and proceeded to build some ramps with the hope that the Go Karts could go over the bus while in a parade group. This was finally perfected and our first outing was the 1972 football game in Hanover. This proved to be a great crowd pleaser and we have attended all of the Northeast conventions since that date.

Our first Imperial Session was in 1974 at Atlantic City and the idea of going down the Boardwalk was quite a fascinating trip. However, we did have a disappointment when one of our Go Karts was stolen during that session.

In 1979, the Corps purchased a 26' trailer that we could house our Karts and provide quarters for changing and the attitude adjustment that is required to get Karts in operating condition. When completed it will be equipped with a generator for its own electrical power, toilet facilities, refrigeration, self contained water supply, and completely carpeted. The rear section which houses the Karts has individual shelves for nine Karts.

We have been indebted to the Northern Vermont Shrine Club for their support of the unit as well as the Mount Sinai Temple.

The group operates with its own bylaws and with all of

the expenses of any trips, equipment or any other activity completely self supported by the membership.

In 1976, we went to the Imperial Session in New York. We were a real big hit there coming down Broadway and performed before our largest crowd and was picked up on network television.

Our first Corps Master was John Rhoades, followed by Bill Tuscany, Larry Larrow, Jack Doubleday, Dick Hersey, John Hubbard, and Clark Hubbard. The group has always been indebted to Dick Hersey for not only his engineering talents but also his mechanical ability.

In 1978 Carroll Hefflon was voted Corps Master Emeritus. He has always been an active participant with the group in showing us how to have a good time.
