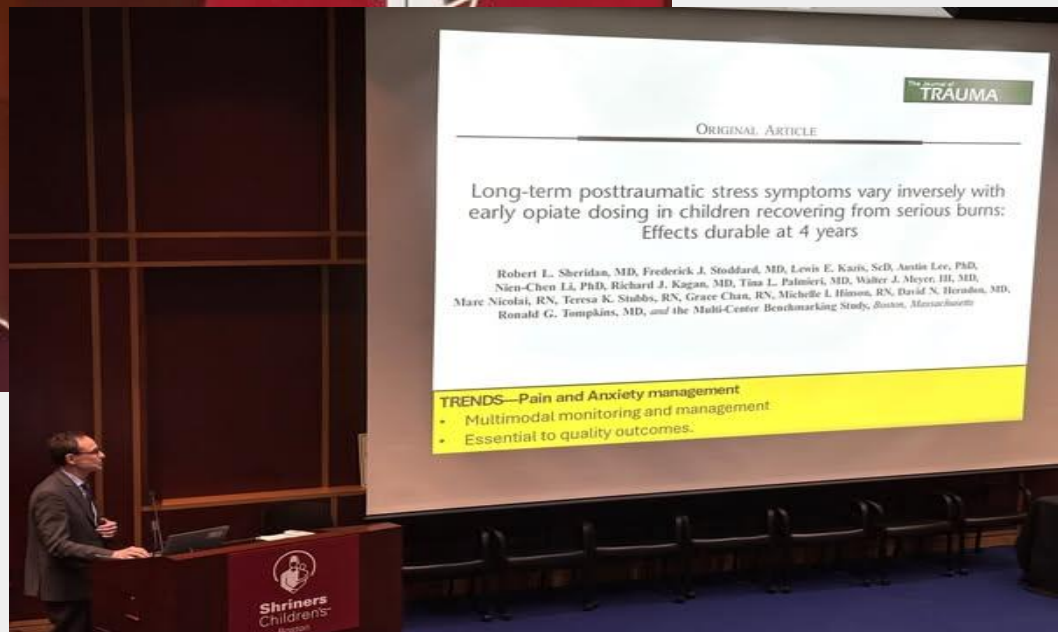


Why we do what we do 100 Years of Being Unstoppable

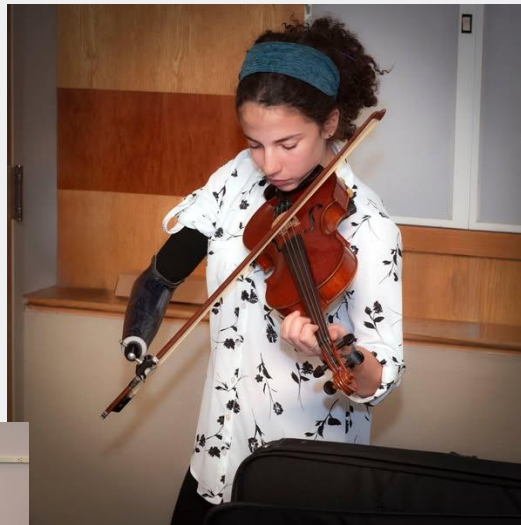

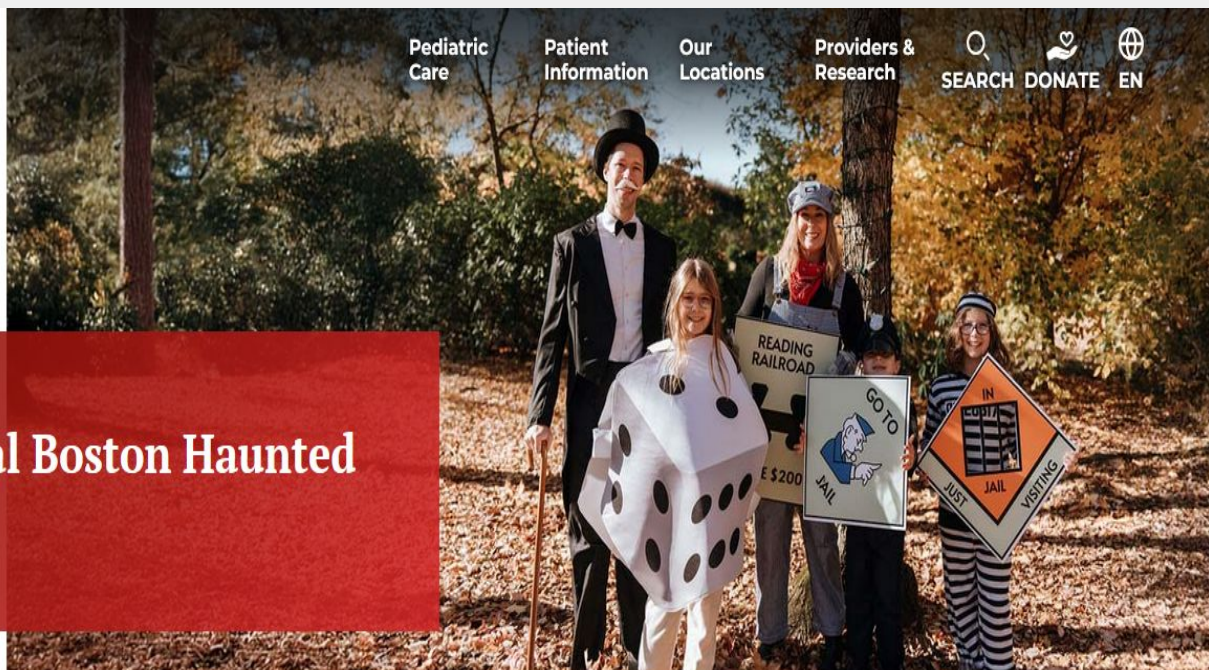
